Waste Oil Drop-Off Procedure

Unfortunately, due to a multitude of unlabeled hazardous household waste that have been deposited in the waste oil container at 277 S Maple Ave., the drop off procedure required modification.

We recommend that residents utilize Somerset County for all Household Hazardous Waste disposal, including cooking/frying oil, at the designated drop offs throughout the year. <https://www.co.somerset.nj.us/government/public-works/recycling/hazardous-waste-days>

In an effort to continue providing convenient **motor oil** recycling drop-off and limit non-accepted chemicals, the following changes have been made:

- Supervised used **motor oil drop-off** occurs during the hours of **7:00am and 3:00pm on Mondays only**.
- Containers must be **clearly labeled** and may be inspected by DPW employees prior to accepting used motor oil, **no other chemicals will be accepted**.
- Upon arrival, please leave used motor oil in your vehicle and check in at the DPW Office on the 2nd floor of the building. The office staff will arrange for a mechanic or other DPW personnel to assist you with drop off.
- **Do not drive through the gate into the yard, enter the mechanic shop or other employee areas unless instructed to do so after checking in.**
