

BERNARDS TOWNSHIP ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION 2023 ANNUAL REPORT

The following is a summary of the 2023 activities of the Bernards Township Environmental Commission ("EC" or "Commission").

MISSION STATEMENT

The Bernards Township Environmental Commission is responsible for ensuring that the environmental issues in Bernards Township, NJ are given the right priority to protect and preserve natural resources of the Township and surrounding areas including land, water, air, and bios (flora and fauna). As a result of NJDEP having oversight of the NJ Historic Preservation Office, occasionally the EC will offer historic preservation comments in accordance with Bernards Township Master Plan.

GOALS

The Commission accomplishes its mission via:

- a) Taking proactive stances on local environmental matters, and strengthening the local planning process
- b) Coordinating rational, balanced reviews of development applications for the appropriate township bodies
- c) Increasing public awareness and understanding of local and regional environmental issues

d) Keeping abreast of, and being involved in, environmental issues that affect our surrounding areas and communities

e) Staying up to date on ordinances and regulations for Bernards Township with training sessions.

2023 SUMMARY

Budget:

In 2023, the EC spent \$450 on the annual ANJEC membership for 10 members.

2023 Accomplishments:

Development Application Reviews: During 2023, the EC held ten meetings – the February meeting was held via Zoom due to inclement weather while the remainder of the meetings were in-person. As an advisory board, the EC continued to provide commentary to the Planning Board, Board of Adjustment and Township Committee regarding environmental impacts and issues. During 2023, the EC reviewed 36 development applications and revisions: 33 Board of Adjustment and 3 Planning Board. In comparison, during 2022, the EC reviewed 35 Board of Adjustment and 6 Planning Board. In addition to reviewing applications for environmental best practices, steep slopes, wetlands, stream buffers, stormwater management etc. this year the members also expanded the focus to include demolition concerns when appropriate (inground tanks, lead paint asbestos) as well as demolition recycling, repurposing, or gifting. Further, the EC also strongly encouraged(s) the planting of native trees and shrubs to help mitigate the decreased water infiltration imposed by new impervious coverage.

Tree Protection: The Environmental Commission works cooperatively with the Township's Shade Tree Commission and Engineering Department to assess tree removal applications. The assessments focus on any safety issues associated with the tree, the health of the tree, and canopy impact. In some cases, site visits are warranted. Typically, tree removals are completed in conjunction with replacement/mitigation measures and replacements focus on native species. In 2023, 14 of these applications were reviewed.

Public Outreach: Throughout the year, about 6 environmentally themed, educational/awareness pieces were posted jointly to the Township website home page and the EC home page + the Township Facebook page. From there, these pieces were shared to several community FB groups such as: Bernards InSight, Bernards Township Community, Basking Ridge Moms, BR Women Lite, Bernards Beat. Topics included different tips on refuse/reduce/reuse/recycle, "tips of the week", plus list of invasive plant/tree species, and Earth Day.

Events/Partnerships/Volunteerism: In March and April, the Bernards Township EC was invited to participate in the second annual GSWA Native Pollinator Plant Sale and promoted the sale via social media. As a returning partner, we mentored the Bernardsville EC who was new to the process. BTEC members also volunteered at the GSWA HQ to prepare all the orders for distribution to the various towns and transported and distributed all the local orders for Bernards Township and Bernardsville residents with assistance from the Friends of Ross Farm and local volunteers.

In November, the EC partnered with the Agricultural Advisory Committee to organize a free Pumpkin Smash held at English Farm/Dogwood Farm to promote pumpkin recycling as well as local farming.

The most significant EC project for 2023 was the design and first phase implementation of a pollinator garden in front of the Bernards Township library. This effort has been a collaboration of residents, resources from Rutgers University, the Bernards Township Department of Public Works, and the Bernards Township Shade Tree Commission. The design is intended to be attractive to pollinators and library patrons as well. Plants were carefully selected based on soil samples as well as rainfall requirements. In the Spring of 2024, we will monitor the health of the plantings and consider additional plants.

At the end of 2023, the EC said goodbye to 1 member. We look forward to serving Bernards Township and its residents in 2024.

Interlocal Services Agreement for the Provision of 2024 Somerset County Recycling Pickup to the Township of Bernards

WHEREAS, the Township of Bernards requires recycling pickup; and

WHEREAS, the County of Somerset has indicated a willingness to provide recycling pickup pursuant to and on the terms set forth herein and, in a contract, dated January 9, 2024; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:48-5 authorizes a municipality to contract with any public or private entity for the provision of any service which the municipality itself could provide directly; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40-:8A-1, et. seq. the Interlocal Services Act, provides the mechanism for making such contract between public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the County of Somerset already has in place a recycling pickup program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards that the following agreement shall be entered into between the Township of Bernards and the County of Somerset, to implement recycling pickup, subject to the terms and provisions set forth below and, in a contract, dated January 9, 2024.

THIS AGREEMENT sets forth the specific provision for the Interlocal Services Agreement between the Township of Bernards and the County of Somerset for recycling pickup for the calendar year 2024 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et. seq., the Interlocal Services Act, as follows:

The rate is \$27.00 per household. The number of households will be adjusted on a quarterly basis, when and if appropriate.



ORDINANCE #2544

An Ordinance of the Township of Bernards to set Calendar Year 2024 Appropriation Limits and to Establish a Cap Bank per N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its Calendar Year 2024 Budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards in the County of Somerset finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2024 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that a 1% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$293,633.25 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and may be necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to the final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards, in the County of Somerset, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2024 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Bernards shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, may be increased up to 3.5 %, amounting to no more than \$1,027,716.39, and that the CY 2024 municipal budget for the Township of Bernards be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This ordinance is an annual housekeeping item that will allow for 2024 "inside the cap" budget appropriations to be increased by more than the 2.5% that the state allows for the current year. This does not mean that the 2024 budget will be increased by this amount but will allow us to "bank" any unused cap money for use in either of the next two succeeding years.
