RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF SOLAR RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDITS TO ERT

WHEREAS, Flett Exchange, a consulting firm retained by the Bernards Township Sewerage Authority, recommends entering into a contract with Constellation, 1310 Point Street, Baltimore, MD 21230 for the sale of the Authorities Solar Renewable Energy Certificates (SRECs), generated by the Authority's Solar Field, and

WHEREAS, Constellation has agreed to a unit firm, three-year contract price of \$226.25 per SREC for year 1, \$211.00 per SREC for year 2, and \$193.00 per SREC for year 3 based on an estimated annual production of 1,150 SRECs; and

WHEREAS, the contract shall be paid based on the actual generation of SRECs by the solar field at the unit price for the reporting years established by the New Jersey State Board of Public Utilities 2023, 2024 and 2025; and

WHEREAS, sale of the SRECs will generate revenues for the Authority, and

WHEREAS, Solar Renewable Energy Certificates ("SRECs"), are defined in the NJ Renewable Energy Portfolio Standards ("RPS") 14:8-2, as amended. An SREC represents the environmental benefits or attributes of one megawatt-hour of generation from an electric generation facility, and are issued by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("NJ BPU"), or its designee, and have been approved by the NJ BPU as a means of compliance with the RPS; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bernards Township Sewerage Authority hereby authorizes the execution of a contract with Constellation for the sale of the Authority's SRECs, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Authority authorizes the Authority Chairperson to sign the contract on behalf of the Authority.
