# RESOLUTION #2318 VACATION OF SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT AT 48 CREST DRIVE BLOCK 8401 LOT 11

**WHEREAS**, the Bernards Township Sewerage Authority sanitary sewer easement runs along the rear yards of properties in Block 8401 as shown on the current tax maps of the Township of Bernards; and

**WHEREAS**, properties of Block 8401, Lots 2 through 10 are connected to the main in the rear yard; and

**WHEREAS**, the main begins at Lot 10 but the easement continues across the rear yard of Lot 11 where there is no sewer main; and

**WHEREAS**, Lots 11 through 15 are connected to the sewer main in the front of the homes in Crest Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, the easement in the rear yard of Lot 11 serves no purpose and the main will not be extended into the easement; and

**WHEREAS**, all available mapping and deeds do not contain a metes and bounds description of the easement on Lot 11 and it appears the easement on Lot 11 was never recorded for Lot 11 as the sewer design changed and Lot 11 was connected to the main in the street; and

**BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Bernards Township Sewerage Authority that the sanitary sewer easement shown on the Township of Bernards tax maps on Block 8401 Lot 11, 48 Crest Drive, shall be vacated and the Authority Director is hereby authorized to sign and execute the quitclaim deed.
